

Class Cancellation Policy

(When train services are suspended)

Tokyo Metropolitan University

<Minami-Osawa Campus>

When classes are cancelled campus-wide in Minami-Osawa due to suspended trains, an official announcement will be posted at the university twitter https://twitter.com/TMU_PR , followed by the university website <http://www.tmu.ac.jp/> .

Following is a guideline for class cancellations when train services are suspended due to snow, windstorm and flood damages, accidents, strike, etc.

1. Any of Keio-sagamihara line, Keio line, JR Yokohama line, or Odakyu-odawara line is out of service as of 6:00 am.

1st and 2nd period classes (8:50 am-12:00 pm) will be cancelled.

2. In addition to the lines mentioned above, any of Odakyu-tama line, JR Nanbu/ Chuo/ Yamanote line, Tama Monorail is fully or partially out of service, which causes or is expected to cause great difficulties in commuting to the university.

Class cancellations will be determined by:

6:00 am for 1st and 2nd period classes (8:50 am-12:00 pm)

10:00 am for 3rd and 4th period classes (1:00 pm-4:10 pm)

1:00 pm for 5th and 6th period classes (4:20 pm-7:30 pm)

3. Guideline above also applies to cancellations of examination. Subsequent response may be arranged separately.

* "Suspended trains" require to be clearly confirmed on TV or radio that the traffic in all the line concerned is being suspended.

* The announcement is posted on Twitter in Japanese only. It is advised that international students should confirm with a friend in in the mutual class regarding the class cancellation status.
